A BILL FOR

An Act relating to trapper's license and fees, and tagging traps.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1), Code
2 1962, is hereby amended by striking all of lines sixty-five (65)
3 through seventy (70) inclusive and inserting the following in
4 lieu thereof:

5 "Trapping license for legal resident of state over sixteen (16)
6 years of age\$3.00.

7 Trapping license for legal resident of state sixteen (16)
8 years of age or less\$1.00."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ten point seventeen (110.17),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

3 All traps used by owners or tenants of land and their chil-
4 dren shall be tagged with the name and address of the owner of
5 the trap."

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred nine point eighty-seven (109.87),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

3 "All traps used for trapping shall be tagged with the name and
4 address of the owner of the trap."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 338

This bill raises the fees for trappers' licenses, but permits a trapper an unlimited number of traps and requires that all traps be tagged with the name and address of the owner.
