A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the division of personnel and employees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section eight point five (8.5), Code 1962, sub-
2 section six b (6b) is hereby amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from lines one (1) and two (2) the words
4 "Through the personnel director, the executive council" and in-
5 serting in lieu thereof the following: "The personnel director,
6 through the budget and financial control committee,".

7 2. By inserting before the word "With" in line ten (10) the
8 following sentence: "Any changes in numbers of employees on
9 tables of organization must have the approval of the personnel
10 director and the budget and financial control committee."

11 3. By striking from lines eleven (11), twenty-six (26),
12 twenty-nine (29) and thirty-three (33) the words "executive
13 council" and inserting in lieu thereof in each instance the
14 following: "budget and financial control committee".

1 Sec. 2. Section eight point five (8.5), Code 1962, is hereby
2 amended by striking paragraph c of subsection six (6) and in-
3 serting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "c. The employees under the attorney general, employees of the
5 supreme court, employees of the clerk and reporter of the supreme
6 court, those employees under the state banking board and the

7 employees of the institutions under the state board of regents
8 shall not come under the division of personnel. The employees in
9 institutions under the board of control, other than professional,
10 executive and administrative personnel, shall not come under this
11 division, with the exception of the provisions established in
12 classification salary ranges and table of organization.”

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred eighteen point six (218.6), Code
2 1962, is hereby amended by adding after the word “compensation”
3 on line thirteen (13) the following: “, within the rules, regu-
4 lations and range of the compensation plan as established by the
5 budget and financial control committee.”.

1 Sec. 4. Section two hundred eighteen point ten (218.10), Code
2 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “shall” in
3 line one (1) the following: “, within the scope of the rules and
4 regulations, range of compensation plan, and table of organization
5 as established by the budget and financial control committee.”.

1 Sec. 5. Section two hundred eighteen point thirteen (218.13),
2 Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following inserted in lieu
3 thereof:

4 “The board shall, within the scope of the rules and regula-
5 tions, range of compensation plan, and table of organization as
6 established by the budget and financial control committee, review
7 and fix the annual, monthly or semimonthly salaries of all em-
8 ployees, except such salaries as are fixed by the general
9 assembly.”

1 Sec. 6. Section two hundred eighteen point fourteen (218.14),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “may” in
3 line eight (8) the following: “, with the approval of the budget

4 and financial control committee.”

1 Sec. 7. Section two hundred fifty-seven point twenty-one
2 (257.21), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking the period
3 after the word “duties” in line five (5) and adding thereto the
4 following: “, within the scope of the rules and regulations,
5 range of compensation plan, and table of organization as estab-
6 lished by the budget and financial control committee.”

1 Sec. 8. Section two hundred fifty-seven point twenty-four
2 (257.24), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all after the
3 period in line three (3) through the period in line seven (7).

1 Sec. 9. This Act being of immediate importance shall be in
2 full force and effect from and after its passage and publication
3 in The Reinbeck Courier, a newspaper published in Reinbeck, Iowa,
4 and The Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper published at
5 Atlantic, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 359

This bill requires approval by the budget and financial control committee for any change in salary structure by a department between legislative sessions. Should a department desire an increase in number of employees or increase in salary ranges, other than that presented to the General Assembly and their current table of organization, they would be required to go through the above procedure. It also puts certain employees of the board of control and employees of the department of public instruction within the personnel functions as practiced by other departments.
