## A BILL FOR

An Act to provide an indemnity for the owner of hogs contracting hog cholera.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. To be entitled to indemnity under this Act:

2 1. Hogs must have been vaccinated against hog cholera at  
3 least fifteen (15) days before the outbreak, and the owner must  
4 furnish sworn affidavit confirming the following requirements:

5 a. All hogs must be permanently identified at the time of  
6 vaccination.

7 b. The date, amount, name of manufacturer, and serial number  
8 of the immunizing product used must be properly recorded.

9 c. The information requested in paragraphs (a) and (b) shall  
10 be forwarded to the division of animal industry, Iowa department  
11 of agriculture in case of a hog cholera outbreak.

1 Sec. 2. The department of agriculture shall make rules  
2 and regulations respecting the official examination of hogs for  
3 hog cholera, the type and method of vaccination, the disposal of  
4 condemned hogs, and the cleaning and disinfecting of the premises  
5 and the proper enforcement of this Act.

1 Sec. 3. The department of agriculture is authorized to enter  
2 any premises where hogs are kept to conduct examinations for  
3 hog cholera and to order the condemnation with indemnity payment  
4 in accordance with this Act whenever such condemnation and in-

5 indemnity payments are necessary for the final eradication of hog  
6 cholera.

1 Sec. 4. Whenever hog cholera is found in any hog or hogs  
2 previously vaccinated and reported, the department may order  
3 such hogs immediately destroyed and prescribe the manner of such  
4 destruction if this is necessary for the control of hog cholera  
5 preparatory to entering into final eradication.

1 Sec. 5. Before hogs are destroyed as provided for in this  
2 Act, they shall be appraised for their cash value by the owner  
3 and a representative of the department of agriculture, a  
4 representative of the United States department of agriculture,  
5 or by the owner or his designated agent and both representatives.

1 Sec. 6. The department of agriculture shall certify the claim  
2 of the owner for each animal destroyed in accordance with this  
3 Act, except that no indemnity will be paid on hogs not eligible  
4 for federal indemnity nor in an amount in excess of that author-  
5 ized by the federal government. Before any indemnity payment is  
6 paid, both state and federal cleaning and disinfecting require-  
7 ments must be met.

1 Sec. 7. There is hereby created a hog cholera indemnity fund  
2 for the payment of such indemnities. All money made available  
3 for indemnity payments shall be placed in this fund.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 365

This bill provides for indemnity payments from federal funds for hogs ordered de-  
stroyed in order to control hog cholera.
