## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the registration of interstate authority with  
the Iowa state commerce commission.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any carrier to perform  
2 an interstate transportation service for compensation upon the  
3 highways of this state without first having secured appropriate  
4 authority from the interstate commerce commission, if such author-  
5 ity is required, and without first having registered such author-  
6 ity, if any, with the Iowa state commerce commission and it  
7 shall be unlawful for any carrier to perform such service for  
8 compensation if authority from the interstate commerce commission  
9 is not required without first having registered with the Iowa  
10 state commerce commission showing that interstate authority is  
11 not required. Such registrations shall be granted upon applica-  
12 tion, without hearing, upon payment of a filing fee in the amount  
13 of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Amendments may be filed without  
14 payment of additional fees.

1 Sec. 2. All fees paid under the provisions of this Act  
2 or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be used for the  
3 administration of this Act and shall be paid to the commission  
4 by warrant drawn from time to time upon the treasurer of state.  
5 Unexpended balances on June 30 of each year shall be credited  
6 to the general fund of the state by December 31 following.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 371

This bill will require motor carriers operating in interstate commerce over the highways of this state to register their operation with the Iowa state commerce commission and provides a reasonable fee to cover costs of administration. Most states have a similar law.
