## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the platting of rural subdivisions.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred six point fifteen (306.15),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all of lines one (1)
- 3 through six (6) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 4 "All road plans, plats, and field notes for rural subdivisions
- 5 shall first be approved by the board of supervisors and the
- 6 county engineer, and then be filed and recorded by the auditor
- 7 before the subdivision is laid out and platted, and if any".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 385

The purpose of this bill is to require the approval of boards of supervisors of any rural subdivision within their county before roads in such subdivisions may become part of the secondary road system and subject to maintenance by the county.
