# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the re-gilding of the domes of the state capitol and to make an appropriation therefor.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The state executive council is hereby authorized

2 to re-gild the state capitol building domes and to enter into

3 contracts to effectuate that purpose. There is hereby appropri-

4 ated to the state executive council from the general fund of the

5 state an amount sufficient to put new gold leaf on all outside

6 areas of the state capitol building domes presently having gold

7 leaf thereon. The above appropriation shall be limited to an

8 amount equal to the difference between the total amount received

9 through any gifts to the state accepted by the executive council

10 to be held in trust for the specific purpose of gilding the

11 domes and the total cost of completing the project. The amount

12 of this appropriation shall be determined as soon after December

13 31, 1963, as is practicable. In the performance of this author-

14 ity the council shall follow as far as are applicable the

15 provisions of section nineteen point twenty (19.20), Code 1962.

1 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall

2 take effect and be in force from and after publication in The

3 Red Oak Express, a newspaper published at Red Oak, Iowa, and in

4 the Adams County Free Press, a newspaper published at Corning,

5 Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 402

The purpose of this bill is to provide for re-gilding the capitol domes. The need for new gold leaf on state capitol building domes is apparent. Contributions have already been sent to state officials for the purpose. This act would insure the completion of the project in the event that gifts to the state do not equal the total cost, by making up the difference with funds from the state treasury.
