## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to speed restrictions of certain motor vehicles.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two hundred
- 2 eighty-five (321.85), Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking from lines three (3) and four (4) of sub-
- 4 section six (6) of such section the word "twenty-four" and in-
- 5 serting in lieu thereof the word "twenty-eight (28)".
- 6 2. By striking from line five (5) of subsection six (6) of
- 7 such section the word "three" and inserting in lieu thereof the
- 8 word "five (5)".
- 9 3. By striking from lines six (6) and seven (7) of subsection
- 10 six (6) of such section the words "and not more than eight feet
- 11 in height".
- 12 4. By inserting in line seven (7) of subsection six (6) of
- 13 such section after the word "width" the words "and equipped with
- 14 a load equalizer hitch".

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 409

To allow motor vehicles pulling a travel trailer, restricted as to size, upon the highway to travel at a speed similar to that allowed one- or two-wheel trailers, including boat trailers. This would differentiate between a travel trailer and a house trailer.
