A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize and empower the state conservation commission to cooperate with the United States government and to accept federal funds for planning, acquisition and development of outdoor recreational areas.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. The state conservation commission is hereby
- 2 authorized and empowered to perform such acts as may be necessary
- 3 to the conduct and establishment of cooperative outdoor
- 4 recreational projects as may be defined by the congress of the
- 5 United States and by rules and regulations of the appropriate
- 6 federal agency and may accept federal funds and assistance for
- 7 the purpose of planning, acquisition and development of outdoor
- 8 recreational projects.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 424

During the 87th Congress of the United States a bill was introduced to create a fund for planning, acquisition and development of outdoor recreational areas. The fund would have been used to match state funds for these purposes. Although the bill was not passed, it is quite likely that it will be again introduced in the present session of Congress. In all instances where grant-in-aid or matching funds are made available by the federal government it is necessary for the local governmental agencies to show authority to accept the funds for the purposes designated.

The purpose of this bill is to provide the necessary authority for the State of Iowa to qualify for any federal grant-in-aid funds that may become available for planning, acquisition and development of outdoor recreational projects.
