A BILL FOR

An Act raising the license fee of fur-dealers and providing for a license for agents and employees of such dealers and setting a fee therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred nine point ninety-five
 2 (109.95), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
 3 following:
 4 "A license shall be required for each person acting as an
 5 agent or employee of a fur dealer when such agent or employee rep-
 6 resents his principal or employer in the buying of furs. The
 7 commission shall, upon application and payment of the required
 8 fee, issue a license to such agent or employee. No fur dealer,
 9 his agent, or employee shall obtain any furs from any person
 10 without first displaying a certificate or license issued by the
 11 commission."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ten point one (110.1), Code 1962,
 2 is hereby amended by striking from line eighty-five (85) the
 3 words and figures "Fur-dealer's license10.00"
 4 and inserting in lieu thereof the words and figures
 5 "License of resident or nonresident agents and
 6 employees of fur dealers10.00
 7 Fur-dealer's license50.00"

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 429

This bill raises the license fee for fur-dealers to \$50. The bill also requires a license for people buying furs for such dealer and fixes a fee of \$10 for such license. The bill also makes it mandatory that a person buying furs show his license to the seller.
