A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the method for amending an ordinance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-six point two,
- 2 (366.2), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking lines
- 3 three (3) through eight (8) and inserting in lieu thereof
- 4 the following:
- 5 "shall be clearly expressed in its title. In amending
- 6 an ordinance, the council may adopt an ordinance directing
- 7 the striking or inserting of words, phrases, paragraphs,
- 8 or subsections, in similar manner to that employed by
- 9 the general assembly for the amendment of this Code.
- 10 When a city or town".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 433

The purpose of this bill is to authorize city and town councils to amend ordinances by the same procedure used by the legislature to amend state statutes. Enactment of this bill would not eliminate publication of changes in ordinances, but it will save publication costs of the parts of ordinances that are not changed. Currently cities and towns must repeal the whole ordinance or section which is changed and enact a new ordinance or section, all of which must be published.
