## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred ninety-six (196), Code 1962, relating to the buying and selling of eggs.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-six point six  
 2 (196.6), Code 1962, is amended by striking all of said section  
 3 after the word "be" in line three (3) and inserting in lieu  
 4 thereof the following: "ten dollars. Each license shall  
 5 expire and is renewable on July first of each year. All  
 6 licenses issued under this section after April 1, 1963, and  
 7 prior to July 4, 1963, are hereby extended to July 1, 1964."

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred ninety-six point twelve  
 2 (196.12), Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following is  
 3 substituted in lieu thereof: "Every person buying eggs from  
 4 producers for resale shall candle such eggs, or cause same  
 5 to be candled, and every person buying eggs from producers  
 6 on a graded basis shall cause same to be candled and graded  
 7 according to U. S. standards for quality for individual eggs.  
 8 Such candling and grading shall be done in the presence of the  
 9 producer if requested."

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred ninety-six point fourteen  
 2 (196.14), Code 1962, is amended by striking lines one (1) to  
 3 six (6) inclusive and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
 4 "All eggs offered for sale at retail must be candled, graded

5 and labeled according to U. S. standards, and no eggs shall be  
6 sold by any other name which might be misleading.  
7 Maximum tolerance of ten percent (10%) may be allowed on quality  
8 in grades. All eggs purchased by a dealer must be held at a  
9 temperature not to exceed sixty degrees Fahrenheit after they  
10 are received at his place of business.”

1 Sec. 4. Section one hundred ninety-six point three (196.3),  
2 Code 1962, is amended by striking the period at the end thereof,  
3 inserting a comma and adding the following: “also any egg  
4 classified as loss or inedible as defined by the United States  
5 standards and grades of eggs.”

#### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 460

These changes are desirable to improve the enforcement of our present law regarding buying and selling of eggs.

#### HOUSE FILE 460

1 Amend House File 460, section 2 by adding at the end of line  
2 seven (7) the following: “In addition thereto, filthy eggs shall  
3 also be deemed unfit for human food and shall be defined as  
4 meaning an egg shell twenty-five (25) percent or more of which is  
5 covered with adhering manure, blood, egg white or yolk, or any  
6 other foreign materials causing putrefaction by any one or  
7 any combination of substances.”
