A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the reversion to the general fund of the state of the unexpended balances of the appropriations made by the Fifty-eighth General Assembly to the state board of regents for support, maintenance, equipment, repairs, replacements and alterations of institutions under said board.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Any unexpended balances remaining in the
- 2 appropriations made by the Fifty-eighth General Assembly to the
- 3 state board of regents for the support, maintenance, equipment,
- 4 repairs, replacements and alterations of the institutions under
- 5 said board of regents, on June 30, 1963, shall revert to the
- 6 general fund of the state.
