A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the reversion of appropriations for capital improvements to the general fund of the state.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Any unencumbered balances remaining as of June 30,
- 2 1965, in any appropriation, from the general fund of the state
- 3 for capital improvements, to any board, commission, institution,
- 4 or state department, made by the fifty-ninth (59th) General
- 5 Assembly, shall revert to the general fund of the state as of
- 6 June 30, 1965.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 473

The purpose of this bill is to establish consistency in the handling of capital appropriation balances and follow the practice of the 58th General Assembly in reverting all old capital appropriation balances to the general fund.
