A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the election of the superintendent of public instruction.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. A superintendent of public instruction shall be
2 elected at the general election in 1964 and each fourth year
3 thereafter in the following manner:

4 1. Any person desiring this office and qualifying in
5 accordance with the provisions of section two hundred fifty-
6 seven point twelve (257.12) of the Code shall file for nomination
7 in accordance with law.

8 2. All persons thus qualifying shall have their names
9 placed on a primary ballot as provided in chapter forty-three
10 (43) of the Code, and all existing statutes relating to
11 nomination and election by direct vote of the people shall
12 apply to the office of superintendent of public instruction.

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred fifty-seven point eleven
2 (257.11), Code 1962, is hereby repealed effective as of the
3 second secular day of January 1965.

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred fifty-seven point twenty-four
2 (257.24), Code 1962, is amended by striking from lines thirteen

3 (13) and fourteen (14) the words "including the state
4 superintendent,".

1 Sec. 4. The term of office of the incumbent superintendent
2 of public instruction shall terminate at midnight on the
3 thirty-first day of December 1964.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 506

This bill provides for the popular election of the state superintendent of public instruction.
