A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the annual salary of the county attorney and his assistants in counties having a population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) and over.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred forty point nine (340.9),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking in line two (2) of
3 subparagraph fifteen (15) the words "ten thousand" and insert-
4 ing in lieu thereof the words "twelve thousand".

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred forty point ten (340.10),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking in line three (3)
3 of subsection two (2) the words "seventy-five" and inserting
4 in lieu thereof the words "eighty-five".

1 Sec. 3. Section three hundred forty point ten (340.10),
2 Code 1962, is hereby further amended by striking in line three
3 (3) of subsection three (3) the word "fifty" and inserting in
4 lieu thereof the words "sixty-five".

1 Sec. 4. Section three hundred forty point ten (340.10),
2 Code 1962, is hereby further amended by striking from line
3 four (4) of subsection three (3) the word "sixty-five" and
4 inserting in lieu thereof the word "eighty-five".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 523

This bill will raise only the salary of Polk County attorney. This would place his salary on a par with the Des Moines city attorney. Also, the criminal business of Polk County is much greater than any other county thereby requiring him to spend his full time discharging his official duties; whereas, the county attorneys in other counties can devote a substantial portion of their time to the private practice of the law.
