A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section seventy-nine point one (79.1), Code 1962, relating to the payment of accrued vacation pay to employees of the state whose employment is terminated.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section seventy-nine point one (79.1), Code 1962,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following after the word
- 3 "commission." in line twenty-one (21) of said section:
- 4 "In the event that the employment of an employee of the
- 5 state who has been in such service more than one year shall
- 6 be terminated for any reason, he shall be paid a vacation
- 7 allowance for any vacation which may have accrued to him but
- 8 which he has not yet taken.
- 9 Vacation allowances for periods of less than one year shall
- 10 be computed as having accrued at the rate of two and one-half
- 11 (2½) days pay for each completed calendar quarter during
- 12 the second and through the ninth year of employment, and at
- 13 the rate of three and three-fourths (3¾) days pay for each
- 14 completed calendar quarter through the tenth and all subsequent
- 15 years of employment.
- 16 If said termination of employment shall be by reason of the
- 17 death of the employee, such vacation allowance shall be paid
- 18 to the surviving widow or widower of the deceased, but if no
- 19 such spouse survives, then it shall be paid to the legal heirs
- 20 of the deceased employee."
