A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section ninety-six point five (96.5), subsection one (1), Code 1962, relating to disqualification for employment security benefits due to voluntarily leaving work.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section ninety-six point five (96.5),
 2 subsection one (1), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking
 3 paragraph "g" and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 4 "g. However, an individual who has left his work
 5 voluntarily without good cause attributable to his employer,
 6 except as provided in paragraphs 'a' through 'f' hereof, shall
 7 forfeit four (4) to nine (9) weeks' benefits as determined
 8 by the commission."

1 Sec. 2. This Act shall be effective with respect to
 2 claims the benefit years of which commence on or after July 4,
 3 1963.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 525

This bill repeals the disqualification for voluntary quit and provides for a penalty of four to nine weeks for voluntary quit.
