**A BILL FOR**

An Act relating to the number of district court judges in the  
eighteenth judicial district.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section six hundred four point eight (604.8),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking the word "four" in
- 3 line sixty-five (65) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof
- 4 the word "five".

**EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 529**

The 18th judicial district, consisting of Cedar, Jones and Linn Counties, has one judge for 43,845 people; whereas, the average for other judicial districts is one judge for approximately 30,000. An additional judge would give the 18th judicial district a judge for every 35,000 people.
