A BILL FOR

An Act to authorize county boards of supervisors to enter into contractual agreements with cities, towns, private corporations or private individuals for the use of dumps, disposal grounds and sanitary land fills operated by such cities, towns, private corporations or private individuals for the use of residents residing outside of cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-two point thirty-
- 2 three (332.33), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding at the
- 3 end thereof the following:
- 4 "The county boards of supervisors may also enter into
- 5 contractual agreements with cities and towns or with private
- 6 corporations and persons for the use by residents of the county
- 7 residing outside of incorporated cities or towns of dumps,
- 8 disposal grounds and sanitary land fills owned or operated by
- 9 cities, towns, private corporations or private individuals and
- 10 that funds from the township dump fund may be used for such
- 11 purpose. County boards of supervisors may also use funds from
- 12 said township dump fund for the purpose of acquiring, constructing,
- 13 operating and maintaining sanitary land fills."
