A BILL FOR

An Act relating to publication of receipts and disbursements of funds collected from student activities.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred seventy-nine (279), Code
2 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new
3 section:
4 "Except in districts of more than one hundred twenty-five
5 thousand (125,000) population, the superintendent of schools of
6 each independent, consolidated, or community school district shall
7 cause to be maintained a record of all receipts and expenditures,
8 other than public funds, relating to all student athletic con-
9 tests, plays, newspapers, school lunches, and other student
10 activities. Immediately following the first eighteen (18) weeks
11 of the school and immediately following the end of the school
12 year, the superintendent shall cause to be published in a news-
13 paper of general circulation in the district, a report which
14 shall show the total receipts and expenditures for each major
15 category of such activity and the balance remaining.
16 Said report shall include a list of expenditures totaling
17 more than five (5) dollars to any one person or firm, including
18 the name of the person or firm to whom payment was made, the
19 reason therefor and the amount thereof. The cost of publishing

20 this report shall be paid from said funds relating to student
21 activities."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 545

The purpose of this bill is to require school districts to publish at the end of each semester a record of all receipts and expenditures of funds derived from and spent on student activities such as athletics, plays, newspapers and school lunches.
