A BILL FOR

An Act to increase the compensation of members of the
state conservation commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred seven point five (107.5),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking in line two (2) the word "ten" and
- 4 inserting in lieu thereof the word "twenty".
- 5 2. By striking in line six (6) the words "six hundred"
- 6 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "one thousand".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 571

This bill increases the compensation of members of the state conservation commission from \$10 to \$20 per day for time employed in discharge of official duties. Since 72 percent of the per diem pay of members of the state conservation commission comes from fish and game receipts, the amount necessary from other sources to make up the balance of proposed increase would be \$4.20 per diem.
