A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter three hundred twenty-six (326), Code 1962, relating to the reciprocity of commercial motor vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred twenty-six (326), Code
- 2 1962, is hereby amended by adding the following section:
- 3 "If the laws of another jurisdiction impose upon the
- 4 vehicles of residents of this state any taxes, fees, charges,
- 5 penalties, obligations, restrictions, prohibitions or
- 6 limitations of any kind additional to those imposed by this
- 7 state upon the vehicles of residents of such other jurisdiction,
- 8 the board is authorized to impose and collect fees or charges
- 9 in like amount to provide for similar obligations, prohibitions
- 10 or limitations upon the owner or operator of a vehicle
- 11 registered in such jurisdiction as long as the laws of such
- 12 other jurisdiction requiring such imposition remain in effect."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 592

The Iowa registered vehicles are now subject to third-structure taxes imposed by a number of jurisdictions which do not have the authority or will not exercise the authority to waive same. The vehicles registered in such other jurisdictions are now being extended full reciprocity without the payment of any third-structure taxes while traveling the highways of this state.
