HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing a constitutional amendment lowering the voting age to eighteen (18).

*Indefinitely
Postponed 2/19*

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
2 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section one (1) of Article two (II) of the Constitution of
4 the State of Iowa is hereby amended by striking from lines two
5 (2) and three (3) the words "twenty one" and inserting in lieu
6 thereof the word "eighteen (18)".

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing amendment is hereby referred to the
2 general assembly to be chosen at the next general election for
3 members of the general assembly and the secretary of state is
4 directed to cause the same to be published for three (3) con-
5 secutive months before the date of said election as provided by
6 law.

EXPLANATION OF H. J. R. 2

This resolution lowers the voting age to eighteen.
