HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing constitutional amendments changing the terms of office of the governor and lieutenant governor from two (2) to four (4) years.

Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
2 the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section two (2) of Article four (IV) of the Constitution of
4 the State of Iowa is hereby amended by striking from line four
5 (4) the word "two" and inserting in lieu thereof the word
6 "four (4)".

7 Section three (3) of Article four (IV) of the Constitution of
8 the State of Iowa is hereby amended by striking from line two (2)
9 the word "two" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four (4)".

10 Section fifteen (15) of Article four (IV) of the Constitution
11 of the State of Iowa is hereby amended by striking from line four
12 (4) the word "two" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "four
13 (4)".

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment is hereby referred
2 to the general assembly to be chosen at the next general election
3 for members of the general assembly and the secretary of state is
4 directed to cause the same to be published for three (3)
5 consecutive months before the date of said election as provided
6 by law.

EXPLANATION OF H. J. R. 4

This resolution increases the term of office of the governor and lieutenant governor to four years.
