A BILL FOR

An Act to make a license a right.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other statute to the
 2 contrary, the granting of any license under the laws of this
 3 state, or under any municipal or county ordinance, shall
 4 create in the grantee a right which shall not, during the
 5 period for which the license was granted, be abridged without
 6 due process of law. Renewal of said license after its expira-
 7 tion shall be mandatory upon proper application and payment
 8 of the license fee and meeting the physical and mental
 9 requisites initially required for obtaining the license,
 10 unless, after notice and hearing, just cause is established
 11 by a preponderance of competent evidence for refusing
 12 renewal.
