A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the elimination of the necessity of fire extinguishers for certain boats.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred six point nine (106.9),
- 2 subsection seven (7), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding
- 3 the following after the word, "accessible." in line nine
- 4 (9):
- 5 "Vessels powered by outboard motors of ten (10) horse-
- 6 power or less, need not carry the extinguishers as provided
- 7 herein."
