A BILL FOR

An Act relating to motor vehicle testing stations in cities and towns.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point
 2 two hundred thirty-nine (321.239), Code 1962, is amended
 3 by striking from lines two (2), three (3), and four (4) the
 4 words “, not exceeding fifty cents per test and not more
 5 than one dollar per year,”.

6 The said section is further amended by striking from lines
 7 eight (8) and nine (9) the words “pay all fees so collected
 8 into the public safety fund” and inserting in lieu thereof
 9 the words “have power to finance the acquisition of sites
 10 and construction and equipment of testing stations from fees
 11 so collected and for such purposes revenue bonds payable
 12 solely and only out of the proceeds of such fees may be
 13 issued in the manner provided in chapter three hundred
 14 ninety-four (394). The annual proceeds from such fees in
 15 excess of the annual amount necessary to be set in a sinking
 16 fund for the retirement of such bonds, both as to principal
 17 and interest, shall be paid into the public safety fund.”

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
 2 hundred forty-five (321.245), Code 1962, is amended by
 3 adding at the end thereof the following:

4 "Supervision and control by the department of public
5 safety over the type of tests and facilities therefore at
6 such testing stations shall be limited to tests for defects
7 expressly prohibited by this chapter."
