## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the practice of accountancy.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred sixteen point nineteen
- 2 (116.19), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line
- 3 eight (8) of subsection one (1) the following: "and with the
- 4 auditor of state,".

### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 257

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate the necessity for establishing two separate and independent process agents as a preliminary requirement when a certified public accountant is temporarily engaged in work in this state.
