A BILL FOR

An Act relating to pharmacies and licenses to operate pharmacies.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section one hundred fifty-five point three

2 (155.3) subsection two (2), Code 1962, is hereby amended by

3 striking in line one (1) the words "drug store" and inserting

4 in lieu thereof the word "place".

1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred fifty-five point ten (155.10),

2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

3 "There shall be three (3) classes of retail pharmacy licenses:

4 Class I. The license issued to a pharmacy which has as its

5 principal business purpose the sale and dispensing of drugs and

6 medicines and compounded prescriptions shall be known as a class

7 I license.

8 Class II. The license issued to a pharmacy in which the sale

9 of drugs and medicine and compounded prescriptions is not the

10 principal business purpose but is only incident thereto shall be

11 known as a class II license.

12 Class III. The license issued to a pharmacy which is main-

13 tained by a hospital as defined in section one hundred thirty-

14 five B point one (135B.1) of the Code, for the compounding of

15 prescriptions for and the dispensing of drugs and medicines to

16 patients therein shall be known as a class III license.

1 Sec. 3. Section one hundred fifty-five point three (155.3)

2 subsection eight (8), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking
3 from lines fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) the words "or to hos-
4 pitals licensed under chapter 135B".
