## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the regulation and licensure by cities and towns of door-to-door solicitation for purpose of tree trimming, insect or pest extermination, and sale or repair of furnaces.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Subsection three (3) of section three
- 2 hundred sixty-eight point six (868.6), Code 1962, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting immediately following the
- 4 word "scavengers," in line three (3) of said subsection,
- 5 the words, "persons who go from door to door offering
- 6 their services for hire as tree trimmers, arborists,
- 7 pest exterminators, or furnace installers and repairmen;"

### EXPLANATION OF SENATE FILE 312

The purpose of this bill is to enable cities and towns to protect their inhabitants from certain door-to-door solicitations that are currently popular; for example, tree services to combat Dutch Elm disease. This bill would permit communities to regulate and license such door-to-door solicitations.
