A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the registration of interstate authority with the Iowa state commerce commission.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any carrier to perform
2 an interstate transportation service for compensation upon the
3 highways of this state without first having secured appropriate
4 authority from the interstate commerce commission, if such au-
5 thority is required, and without first having registered such au-
6 thority, if any, with the Iowa state commerce commission and it
7 shall be unlawful for any carrier to perform such service for
8 compensation if authority from the interstate commerce commission
9 is not required without first having registered with the Iowa
10 state commerce commission showing that interstate authority is
11 not required. Such registrations shall be granted upon applica-
12 tion, without hearing, upon payment of a filing fee in the amount
13 of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). Amendments may be filed without
14 payment of additional fees.

1 Sec. 2. All fees paid under the provisions of this Act
2 or so much thereof as may be necessary shall be used for the
3 administration of this Act and shall be paid to the commission
4 by warrant drawn from time to time upon the treasurer of state.
5 Unexpended balances on June 30 of each year shall be credited
6 to the general fund of the state by December 31 following.
