A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter two hundred thirty-nine, Code 1962,
relating to aid to dependent children.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-nine point two
- 2 (239.2), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding to subsection
- 3 one (1) thereof the following sentence: "However, if a
- 4 recipient mother of one illegitimate child shall, while a
- 5 recipient, give birth to a second illegitimate child, said
- 6 birth shall be prima facie evidence that the home maintained
- 7 by said recipient shall not, for the purpose of this chapter,
- 8 be a suitable home."
- 1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred thirty-nine point four (239.4),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
- 3 paragraph: "The investigation shall also ascertain insofar as
- 4 possible, the names, addresses or whereabouts, description, and
- 5 social security numbers of all persons legally responsible for
- 6 the support of the child and all such other information pertinent
- 7 thereto as the county attorney may request. When deemed
- 8 necessary by the county attorney, the county board shall
- 9 communicate with the social security administration to determine
- 10 the whereabouts and earnings of a responsible relative, and
- 11 shall make all information discovered thereby available to the
- 12 county attorney."

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred thirty-nine point five
2 (239.5), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from lines
3 fifty-two (52) and fifty-three (53), the words "the county
4 board of social welfare, with the advice of".

1 Sec. 4. Section two hundred thirty-nine point six
2 (239.6), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking in lines
3 four (4), five (5) and six (6), the words "shall be reinvesti-
4 gated and reconsidered by the county board as frequently as may
5 be required", and inserting in lieu thereof the words: "each
6 county board shall direct that each assistance grant shall be
7 reinvestigated at least once each month, which reinvestigation
8 shall include an unannounced visit to the home of the child
9 and an inspection of the child".

1 Sec. 5. Section two hundred thirty-nine point ten
2 (239.10), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting between
3 the words "by" and "persons" in line (5) thereof the words:
4 "the attorney general, the county attorney and".
