## A BILL FOR

An Act to provide an indemnity for the owner of hogs contracting hog cholera.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Definition. "Approved vaccinate" shall mean:

2 1. Hogs must have been vaccinated against hog cholera and  
3 reported at least fifteen days prior to the outbreak of cholera.

4 2. All hogs must be permanently indentified at the time of  
5 vaccination.

6 3. The amount, name of manufacturer and serial number of the  
7 immunizing product used must be properly recorded.

8 4. The information requested in subsections one (1), two (2)  
9 and three (3) shall be immediately forwarded to the division of  
10 animal industry, Iowa department of agriculture.

1 Sec. 2. The state department of agriculture may make rules  
2 and regulations respecting the official examination of hogs for  
3 hog cholera, the type and method of vaccination, the disposal  
4 of condemned hogs, the cleaning and disinfecting of the premises  
5 and the proper enforcement of this Act.

1 Sec. 3. The department is authorized to enter any premises  
2 where such hogs are kept to conduct examination for hog cholera  
3 to order the condemnation with indemnity payment in accordance  
4 with section five (5) of this Act, whenever in the opinion of  
5 the Iowa secretary of agriculture such condemnation and indemni-

6 ty payments are necessary for the final eradication of hog  
7 cholera.

1 Sec. 4. Whenever hog cholera is found in any hog or hogs  
2 previously so vaccinated and reported, the department may order  
3 such hogs immediately destroyed forthwith and prescribe the  
4 manner of such destruction, if in the opinion of the secretary  
5 of agriculture this is deemed necessary for the control of hog  
6 cholera preparatory to entering into final eradication.

1 Sec. 5. Before such hogs are destroyed they shall be appraised  
2 for their cash value by the owner and a representative of the  
3 state department, or a representative of the United States de-  
4 partment of agriculture, or by the owner or his designated agent  
5 and both representatives.

1 Sec. 6. The department shall certify the claim of the owner  
2 for each animal destroyed in accordance with this Act except  
3 that no indemnity will be paid on hogs not eligible for federal  
4 indemnity nor in an amount in excess of that authorized by the  
5 federal government. Before any indemnity payment both state and  
6 federal cleaning and disinfecting requirements must be met.

1 Sec. 7. There is hereby created a hog cholera indemnity fund  
2 for the payment of such indemnities. All money made available  
3 for such payments shall be placed in said fund.
