A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the exemption of certain nonprofit organizations providing special educational facilities not provided in chapter two hundred eighty-one (281), Code 1962, from the motor vehicle registration fees and the state motor fuel tax.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point nineteen
2 (321.19), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
3 following:
4 "Vehicles owned by a nonprofit organization which provides
5 special education to children as defined in section two hundred
6 eighty-one point two (281.2) of the Code, are hereby exempted from
7 the payment of the fees prescribed in this chapter, but shall not
8 be exempt from the penalties provided herein. Such exemption
9 shall be permitted only where special education facilities as
10 provided in section two hundred eighty-one point four (281.4)
11 of the Code, are not made available to such children.

12 Upon application by such organization, the department shall
13 furnish free of charge distinguishing plates for vehicles thus
14 exempted and the department shall keep a record of such plates."

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-four point seventeen
2 (324.17), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line
3 nine (9) after the word "highways" the words " , or for use in
4 motor vehicles owned by a non-profit organization which provides
5 special education to children as defined in section two hundred

6 eighty-one point two (281.2) of the Code, where special education
7 facilities are not made available to such children as provided in
8 section two hundred eighty-one point four (281.4) of the Code.”
