A BILL FOR

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the road use	
2	tax fund of the state of Iowa, as provided in chapter three hun-	
3	dred twelve (312), Code 1962, to the following persons the	
4	amounts set opposite their respective names in full settlement	
5	of all claims which they may have against the state of Iowa on	
6	account of services rendered as a member of the committee on	
7	highway study:

2 his warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated,

2 ties shall be in full settlement of all claims against the state
3 of Iowa growing out of the above described claims.
