An Act relating to the confirmation of appointments by the senate and the eligibility of rejected nominees to interim appointments.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section two point forty (2.40), Code 1962, is
- 2 amended by adding the following:
- 3 "When a nomination has been so considered by the senate and
- 4 approval has been refused, the nominee shall not be eligible for
- 5 an interim appointment, prior to the convening of the general
- 6 assembly in the next regular session, to any position requiring
- 7 confirmation by the senate."
