A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to members of legislative advisory committees.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general
2 fund of the state of Iowa to the following named persons the

5 account of services rendered as a member of a legislative advisory
6 committee established by the legislative research committee
7 by the authority of sections two point fifty-five (2.55) and two
