A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the State of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the sum of one million one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,150,000.00) to carry on soil conservation work in soil conservation districts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund
- 2 of the State of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the
- 3 sum of five hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000.00) for
- 4 each year of the biennium beginning July 1, 1963, and ending June
- 5 30, 1965, or so much thereof as may be necessary to carry on soil
- 6 conservation work in soil conservation districts organized under
- 7 the soil conservation districts law of the State of Iowa. The
- 8 fund shall be used as follows:
- 9 1. Aid to soil conservation districts for district commission-
- 10 ers' expenses, stationery, postage and other uses as they may be
- 11 authorized by the state soil conservation committee; five hundred
- 12 dollars (\$500.00) per district. Total fifty thousand dollars
- 13 (\$50,000.00).
- 14 2. Personnel (technicians and clerical personnel), and their
- 15 necessary expenses including office rental, equipment and materials
- 16 to be assigned to the soil conservation districts by the state
- 17 soil conservation committee on a need basis; four hundred seventy-
- 18 five thousand dollars (\$475,000.00).
- 1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund of

2 the State of Iowa to the state soil conservation committee the sum
3 of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) for each year of the bien-
4 nium beginning July 1, 1963, and ending June 30, 1965, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, to be used and expended in participa-
6 tion and conjunction with the federal government or any of its
7 agencies in joint operations of watershed planning and development
8 within the State of Iowa.
