## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing constitutional amendments relating  
to public officers within the State of Iowa.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The following amendments to the Constitution of the  
2 State of Iowa are hereby proposed:

3 AMENDMENT NO. 1

4 Section 2 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of  
5 Iowa is amended by striking therefrom the words "two years" and  
6 inserting in lieu thereof the words "four years".

7 Section 3 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of  
8 Iowa is amended by striking therefrom the words "two years" and  
9 inserting in lieu thereof the words "four years".

10 Section 15 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of  
11 Iowa is amended by striking therefrom the words "two years" and  
12 inserting in lieu thereof the words "four years".

13 AMENDMENT NO. 2

14 Section 22 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of  
15 Iowa is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof.

16 "A Secretary of State, Auditor of State, Secretary of Agricul-  
17 ture and Treasurer of State shall be elected by the qualified  
18 electors, who shall continue in office four years, until their  
19 successors are elected and qualified; and perform such duties as

20 may be required by law. Provided, the term of office of the  
21 Auditor of State, Secretary of Agriculture and Treasurer of State,  
22 elected at the time of the adoption of this amendment, shall be  
23 for two years."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 3

25 Section 12 of Article V of the Constitution of Iowa is amended  
26 by striking therefrom the words "two years" and inserting in lieu  
27 thereof the words "four years."

28 AMENDMENT NO. 4

29 The 4th amendment of the year 1884 to the Constitution of the  
30 State of Iowa, adopted as Section 13 of Article V, is hereby  
31 repealed.

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment is hereby referred  
2 to the legislature to be chosen at the next general election for  
3 members of the general assembly, and the secretary of state shall  
4 cause the same to be published for three (3) months previous to  
5 the date of said elections as provided by law.
