## SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

A Joint Resolution proposing to give the governor item veto power on appropriations bills by amending the Constitution.

*Be It Resolved by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution  
2 of the State of Iowa is hereby proposed:

3 Section sixteen (16) of Article three (III) of the Consti-  
4 tution of the State of Iowa is hereby amended by adding the  
5 following new paragraph:

6 "Appropriation bills may be approved in whole or in part by  
7 the Governor and the part approved shall become a law. Any  
8 item objected to by the Governor shall be returned with his  
9 objections to the house in which it originated in the same  
10 manner as provided for other bills; and any such item may be  
11 enacted into law notwithstanding the Governor's objections in  
12 the same manner as provided for other bills."

1 Sec. 2. The foregoing proposed amendment is hereby referred  
2 to the General Assembly to be chosen at the next general elec-  
3 tion for members of the General Assembly and the secretary of  
4 state is directed to cause the same to be published for three  
5 (3) consecutive months previous to the date of said election as  
6 provided by law.
