

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

A Concurrent Resolution requesting the legislative council to establish a study committee to consider options for simplifying Iowa's income taxation in a revenue-neutral manner.

WHEREAS, income taxes are a vital component of the revenue used to provide the important government services that citizens have come to rely upon; and

WHEREAS, Iowa's system of income taxation has been criticized for its complexity compared to the income taxation systems of other states; and

WHEREAS, options exist to simplify Iowa's income taxation system in a revenue-neutral manner; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING, That the legislative council is requested to establish a study committee for the 2001 legislative interim to consider options for simplifying Iowa's income taxation system in a revenue-neutral manner and to provide findings and recommendations for consideration by the Seventy-ninth General Assembly, 2002 Regular Session.
