3 A Concurrent Resolution to request that the Legislative
4 Council establish an interim committee to study
5 issues relating to water quality.

6 WHEREAS, water quality is a vital issue of concern
7 to the residents of the state; and

8 WHEREAS, it is necessary to examine impacts on the
9 state's water quality and the state's role in
10 preserving, enhancing, and remediating the quality of
11 surface and subsurface water; NOW THEREFORE,

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE
13 SENATE CONCURRING, That the Legislative Council is
14 requested to create a water quality interim committee
15 to study the quality of the state's surface and
16 subsurface waters, including drinking water sources.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if created, the
18 interim committee consider all major sources of
19 contamination, current effluent and treatment
20 standards, and practices or systems designed to
21 prevent or reduce contamination.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if created, the
23 Department of Agriculture and Land Stewardship and the
24 Department of Natural Resources cooperate with the
25 interim committee.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That if created, the
27 interim committee, as directed by the Legislative
28 Council, report to the General Assembly regarding any
29 recommendations required to improve water quality in
30 the state, including legislative measures to reduce
