**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to marketing, educational, and informational  
2 expenses of the lottery.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 17

1 Section 1. Section 99E.10, subsection 1, unnumbered  
2 paragraph 2, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 Lottery expenses for marketing, educational, and  
4 informational material shall not exceed four-percent the  
5 amount of the gross lottery revenue contributed to the  
6 gambling treatment fund as provided in paragraph "a".

7 EXPLANATION

8 The bill limits the amount of money spent by the state  
9 lottery for information, education, and marketing to the same  
10 amount that is allocated to the gambling treatment fund. This  
11 amount would be equal to three-tenths of one percent of the  
12 gross lottery revenue as provided in Code section 99E.10.

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
