## A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to the powers and duties of the executive  
2 director of the commission of veterans affairs by providing  
3 for the recognition of honor guard units of veterans  
4 organizations to perform honor guard services.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 73

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 35A.12 MILITARY VETERAN HONOR  
2 GUARD SERVICES.

3 1. As used in this section, "recognized military veterans  
4 organization" means a veterans organization listed in section  
5 35A.2 or 37.2, or an organization of veterans of the United  
6 States armed forces recognized by rule of the director.

7 2. The director shall provide, by rule, for the  
8 designation of honor guard units of recognized military  
9 veterans organizations to perform honor guard services for  
10 public ceremonies, parades, and related functions in this  
11 state. An honor guard unit given official recognition  
12 pursuant to this section shall be allowed to perform any honor  
13 guard services on public property. The director shall adopt  
14 the rules required under this section pursuant to chapter 17A.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill provides that the executive director of the  
17 commission of veterans affairs shall provide, by rule, for the  
18 designation of honor guard units of recognized military  
19 veterans organizations to perform honor guard services. An  
20 honor guard unit given official recognition pursuant to this  
21 section shall be allowed to perform honor guard services for  
22 public ceremonies, parades, and related functions on public  
23 property in this state. The executive director shall adopt  
24 the rules required under this section pursuant to chapter 17A.
