1 Section 1. The department of economic development shall
2 establish and implement a former Iowan recruitment pilot
3 program. Under the program, the department shall provide
4 grants to local chambers of commerce which shall be used for
5 purposes of encouraging former Iowans attending local high
6 school class reunions to relocate in Iowa.

7 Sec. 2. FORMER IOWAN RECRUITMENT. There is appropriated
8 from the general fund of the state to the department of
9 economic development for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
10 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, the following amount, or so
11 much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose
12 designated:

13 For the former Iowan recruitment pilot program as
14 established by the department pursuant to this Act, including
15 salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes:
16 \$ 200,000

17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill provides for the establishment of a former Iowan
19 recruitment pilot program. The bill provides that the
20 department shall provide grants to local chambers of commerce
21 which shall be used for purposes of encouraging former Iowans
22 attending local high school class reunions to relocate in
23 Iowa. The bill appropriates \$200,000 from the general fund to
24 the department of economic development for the fiscal year
25 beginning July 1, 2001, for purposes of the pilot program.
