1 Section 1. Section 321.457, subsection 2, paragraph d,  
2 Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

3 d. A combination of three vehicles coupled together one of  
4 which is a motor vehicle, unladen or with load, other than a  
5 truck tractor, shall not have an overall length, inclusive of  
6 front and rear bumpers, in excess of ~~sixty~~ seventy feet.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill amends a provision in Code section 321.457  
9 relating to the maximum length of vehicles operated on  
10 highways in the state to modify the maximum overall length  
11 allowed for a combination of three vehicles coupled together,  
12 one of which is a motor vehicle other than a truck tractor.  
13 The maximum overall length for such a combination is extended  
14 from 60 to 70 feet.
