1 Section 1. Section 99D.22, subsection 2, paragraph b, Code  
2 2001, is amended by adding the following new subparagraph:

3 NEW SUBPARAGRAPH. (4) Continuous residency for at least  
4 one hundred eighty days for an Iowa-foaled brood mare before  
5 the foal is dropped.

6 Sec. 2. Section 99D.22, subsection 2, Code 2001, is  
7 amended by adding the following new paragraph after paragraph  
8 b:

9 NEW PARAGRAPH. bb. A brood mare producing Iowa-foaled  
10 horses that are eligible for Iowa-foal supplemental winnings  
11 as provided in this section must be bred to an Iowa registered  
12 stallion every other year.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that an Iowa-foaled brood mare must  
15 reside in the state continuously for 180 days before a foal is  
16 dropped if the foal is to be eligible for supplemental  
17 winnings as an Iowa-foaled racehorse.

18 The bill also provides that a brood mare producing Iowa-  
19 foaled horses that are eligible for Iowa-foal supplemental  
20 winnings from the Iowa horse and dog breeders fund must be  
21 bred to an Iowa registered stallion every other year.
