1 Section 1. RESIDENT ADVOCATE COORDINATORS. There is
2 appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
3 department of elder affairs for the fiscal year beginning July
4 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, the following amount, or so
5 much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purpose
6 designated:

7 For additional resident advocate committee support:
8 \$ 90,000

9 Funds appropriated in this section shall be disbursed by
10 the director of the department of elder affairs over a two-
11 year period to assist resident advocate coordinators employed
12 through area agencies on aging in providing training and
13 assistance to volunteer members of resident advocate
14 committees.

15 EXPLANATION

16 This bill appropriates from the general fund of the state
17 to the department of elder affairs for the fiscal year
18 beginning July 1, 2001, and ending June 30, 2002, \$90,000.
19 The bill provides that the funds shall be disbursed by the
20 director of the department of elder affairs over a two-year
21 period to assist resident advocate coordinators employed
22 through area agencies on aging in providing training and
23 assistance to volunteer members of resident advocate
24 committees.
