1 Section 1. Section 101.22, subsection 4, Code 2001, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 4. The initial registration notice of the owner or
4 operator to the state fire marshal under subsections 1 through
5 3 shall be accompanied by a fee of ten dollars for each tank
6 included in the notice. All moneys collected shall be
7 retained by the department of public safety and are
8 appropriated for the use of the state fire marshal. The

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill amends Code section 101.22 relating to
14 registration and renewal fees paid to the state fire marshal's
15 office within the department of public safety for aboveground
16 petroleum storage tanks.

17 Currently, an owner or operator of an aboveground petroleum
18 storage tank must pay a fee upon registering the tank with the
19 state fire marshal's office and pay an annual renewal fee each
20 year after the tank is registered. The bill eliminates the
21 annual renewal fee requirement.
