A BILL FOR

1 An Act amending the strategic planning duties of the Iowa
2 economic development board.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 15.104, subsections 1, 2, 3, and 8,
2 Code 2001, are amended to read as follows:

3 ~~1. Develop and coordinate the implementation of a twenty-~~

32 EXPLANATION

33 This bill amends the strategic planning duties of the Iowa
34 economic development board. The bill eliminates the
35 requirements of the board to coordinate and implement a 20-

1 year comprehensive economic development plan for the state and
2 to prepare a five-year strategic plan for state economic
3 growth. The bill provides that the board shall prepare a
4 three-year comprehensive strategic plan of specific goals,
5 objectives, and policies for state economic growth.

RE: Update Duties of the IDED Board



In the current Iowa Code, the Iowa Department of Economic Board is charged with coordinating and implementing a twenty-year comprehensive economic development plan and a five-year comprehensive strategic plan. In the new technology driven economy, a twenty-year comprehensive plan will become outdated in a matter of a couple years and lends itself to an archaic method of planning.

The Department is proposing to change to board duties to reflect the development of a three-year comprehensive strategic plan of specific goals, objectives, and policies for state economic growth. This change will also assist in addressing the economic development needs at that time instead of assuming they will remain constant.

The code chapter and section defining the board duties is 15.104

AN ACT

AMENDING THE STRATEGIC PLANNING DUTIES OF THE IOWA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15.104, subsections 1, 2, 3, and 8, Code 2001, are amended to read as follows:

~~1. Develop and coordinate the implementation of a twenty-year comprehensive economic development plan of specific goals, objectives, and policies for the state. This plan shall be updated annually and revised as necessary. All other state agencies involved in economic development activities shall annually submit to the board for its review and potential inclusion in the plan their goals, objectives, and policies.~~

2. Prepare a five-year three-year comprehensive strategic plan of specific goals, objectives, and policies for state economic growth to ~~implement the specific comprehensive goals, objectives, and policies of the state.~~ All other state agencies involved in economic development activities shall annually submit to the board for its review and potential inclusion in the strategic plan their specific strategic plans and programs. The five-year three-year strategic plan for state economic growth shall be updated annually.

3. Develop a method of evaluation of the attainment of goals and objectives from pursuing the policies of the ~~five-year and twenty-year plans~~ three-year plan.

8. Review grants or contracts awarded by the department, with respect to the department's adherence to the guidelines and procedures and the impact on the five-year three-year strategic plan for economic growth.

Sec. 2. Section 15.106, subsection 8, Code 2001, is amended to read as follows:

8. Seek to implement the plans comprehensive strategic plan approved by the board under section 15.104, ~~subsections 1 and subsection 2.~~
